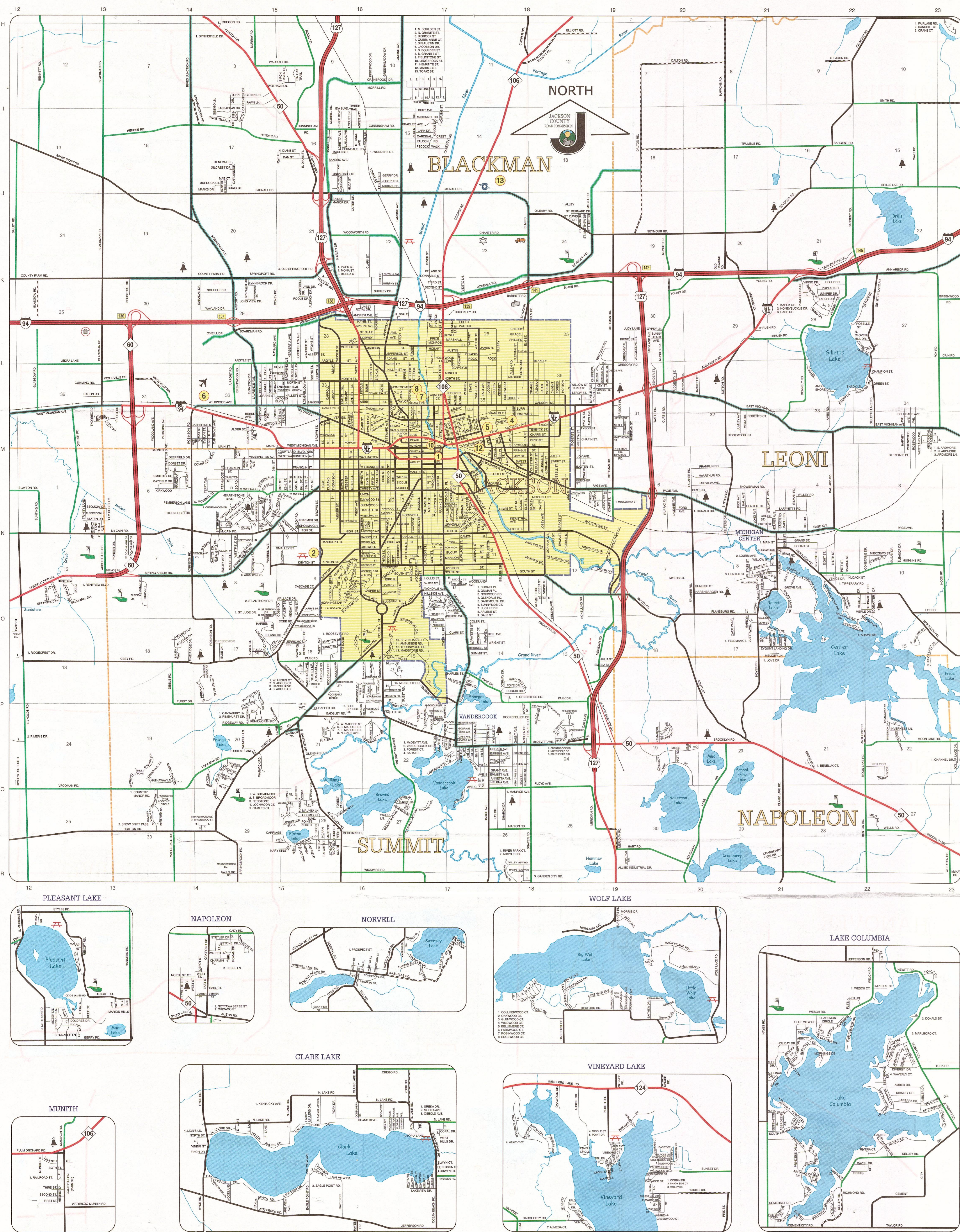

Jackson County has a total area of 720 square miles including nineteen townships and the City of Jackson. The elevation varies from 300 feet to 1200 feet above sea level. Four principal Michigan rivers rise near or within its boundaries. The Grand River and Kalamazoo River flow westward into Lake Michigan; the Raisin River and the Huron River flow eastward into Lake Erie.

The population of Jackson County (2000 census) including the City of Jackson and six incorporated villages is 158,422 with the City of Jackson having 36,316 of the total. The population of six incorporated villages vary in size from 424 to 1,776 with a total of 5,394.

Jackson County has a total road mileage of 1,840 miles of which 255 miles are paved State Trunklines and 1,273 miles are paved county road.

There are 15 county parks within Jackson County operated by the Jackson County Park Commission with facilities for boating, picnicking, camping, and other park recreation. Six parks where camping is permitted, electric, water and sewage disposal service is available.

Sparks Foundation County Park comprising 47 acres, located in and adjacent to the southwest part of the City of Jackson, contains the famous Bluewater Golf Course. The Bluewater Golf Course within the park is one of the finest eighteen hole Public Courses in Southeast Michigan. The Waterloo Recreation Area, located in the northeast part of the county is under the supervision of the Michigan Department of Natural Resources, and has facilities for boating, picnicking and camping.

Jackson industry pioneered the manufacture of automobiles; over 23 were produced. Such cars as the DeSoto, Cutler, Imperial, Green, Marlin, Handy, Carter, Car, Jackson, Earl and Buick were originally manufactured in Jackson Michigan.
